Rather than attending a traditional language school, students develop their English naturally through complete immersion in everyday school life, whilst experiencing British culture in a safe, supportive and inspiring environment.

For older students aged 16–17, our Future Ready – UK University & Boarding Experience combines English language development with academic enrichment and specialist university preparation. Students join Sixth Form lessons alongside Strathallan pupils, participate fully in boarding life and benefit from bespoke workshops covering UCAS applications, Conservatoire admissions, Medicine, Law and other competitive university pathways. The programme also includes visits to leading universities across Scotland and England, helping students gain first-hand insight into higher education in the United Kingdom.

Our aim is to provide much more than an English language course. We seek to develop confident, globally minded young people through authentic educational experiences that promote academic ambition, cultural understanding, independence and personal growth.

We believe these programmes closely reflect the objectives of the Italian Government's mobility initiative by combining educational excellence, language acquisition, cultural exchange and university preparation within one of the United Kingdom's leading boarding schools.
